Remember the first time you bit into an exceptionally juicy local strawberry in the early summertime? Or how refreshing a glass of local milk tasted the first time it washed down your favorite cookie? NH House Bill 1678-FN is aiming to give that experience to more kids across the state at an earlier age though their school meal programs. The Local Food for Local Schools Pilot Project Reimbursement Bill will incentivize schools to purchase quality ingredients from NH farmers, benefiting our farmers, our youth, and our local economy all at the same time. The Littleton Food Co-op is a proud supporter of this bill, and we encourage you to learn more about it and see if you are, too.
