Cambozola Black



Do you love blue cheese? Do you want to love blue cheese? Then Cambozola Black is the gateway blue for you. Aged 2-4 months, Cambozola Black (think camembert and gorgonzola) is a triple-creme, pasteurized cow's milk cheese from the award winning German creamery, Kaserei Champignon, in

Bavaria. Allowed to ripen slowly and at a lower temperature than typical, Cambozola Black develops a dusky, soft gray, bloomy rind and a silken, luxurious texture. The blue veining laced throughout the paste offers a peppery balance to the rich, complex, buttery, mushroomy and slightly salty flavors of this decadent cheese. Cambozola Black pairs beautifully with fresh or dried fruits, smoked meats, sweet wines (red or white), and dark beers. And it is superb with a perfectly cooked steak and a glass of champagne.
