MOSES REAPER



From the caves of Jasper Hill rises a cheese cloaked in mystery and mischief-Moses Reaper, the ghoulish twin of the beloved Moses Sleeper. This limited-edition, Halloween-ready wheel is crafted with pasteurized cow milk and ripened under a veil of vegetable ash, creating a striking contrast between its dark, eerie rind and glowing jack o' lantern-orange paste,

naturally tinted with annatto. Beneath its spooky exterior lies a bloomy-rind cheese that's anything but frightful. Moses Reaper is rich and buttery with hauntingly savory notes of roasted mushrooms, buttered popcorn, and a hint of autumn woods after the rain. The texture is supple and luscious, becoming even more decadent as it ripens through October. Perfect for fall gatherings and haunted harvest boards, Moses Reaper pairs eerily well with tart apples, crusty sourdough, hot honey, and even a glass of Casca Macération de Soif Sauvignon Blanc under a full moon. Whether you're sneaking bites between trick-or-treaters or laying out a midnight cheese altar, this seasonal stunner is sure to raise some eyebrows (and the dead).




Scrumptious Fall Soaps
