

At participating farmers' markets, farm stands, CSAs, and grocery retailers (that's us!) Market Match increases the purchasing power of shoppers who use SNAP/EBT. Folks can do their shopping as planned and then receive a discount on fruit and vegetable purchases - including local items!- when paying with a SNAP/EBT card at checkout. This allows families to increase their healthy produce intake while on a limited set budget.

Programs like Market Match keep the autonomy of food shopping in the hands of local families, meaning children can discover their favorite vegetable, less food is wasted, and more families can continue creating memories around healthy food at the table.

During the month of October, Littleton Co-op shoppers raised \$9,015.74 for Market Match through our Partner of the Month program. Thank you for helping keep this vital benefit alive!

Extra Benefits for HFA Members



Our Healthy Food Access Program is designed to make food more accessible to everyone in our community, regardless of income. Co-op Members who receive SNAP, SSI, or other qualifying supplemental assistance can sign up for a discount on eligible items every time they shop.

This November we've raised the discount for our Healthy Food Access Program from 10% to 15%. This new discount will be automatically applied at checkout during November.

HFA members are also eligible for a \$40 Co-op Gift Card - just stop by the Service Desk between Nov 17 through Nov 22. The primary member must sign for the card at pickup before the end of day on November 22.

Beaujolais is Back!

Tis the season for our wine connoisseurs: it's time for BEAUJOLAIS!

Les Beaujolais Nouveaux has an interesting story. Dating back to the 1800's, it was the wine to celebrate the end of the harvest in France.

In the early 1900's, the French authorities decided not to release the wine before December 15th; but that later changed to November 15th in the 1950's. By 1985, the 'Institut National de l'Origine et de la Qualité (INAO)— the French organization that regulates French agricultural products with protected designations of origins— declared the release date as the third Thursday in November, to consumers globally.

Beaujolais was first exported to New York City, in 1972. In the Beaujolais region in eastern France, the wine is made from 100% Gamay grapes. Gamay is a red grape, famous for its light and fruity body.

Domaine des Nugues Beaujolais is a 4th generation small family-owned winery managed by the husband and wife team of Gilles and Magali Gelin. They produce less than ten thousand cases per year of all their wines.

We're happy to carry Les Beaujolais Nouveau Wine during this Holiday Season. It arrives just in time for the holidays and pairs beautifully with all your favorite holiday food, including turkey, pies, and cheeses.

The 2025 Beaujolais Villages Nouveau will be at the Co-op on Friday, November 21st, and on sale through November 26th. Cheers!!
