SNAP / EBT Alert:

LIMITED TIME ONLY! 2024 Summer EBT (S-EBT) offered Nov. 15th - Dec. 15th, 2024.

Families with children may be eligible for an additional \$120 in grocery benefits per child through S-EBT.

There are 3 ways to receive your additional grocery money.

- 1. Families automatically receive benefits on a new S-EBT card if their child was enrolled in SNAP or TANF. Also, if your child was on Medicaid AND on free/reduced price school meals during the 2023-2024 school year.
- 2. If not in the above programs and your child was enrolled in free/reduced school meals last year ('23-'24), you MUST give your address only to DHHS to receive the grocery card here:

Steps to receive S-EBT benefits:


- 1. Visit nheasy.nh.gov
- 2. Click the Summer EBT portal
- 3. Enter your address before December 15th, 2024, to receive your grocery money card.
- 3. If you have school-aged children but are not in 1 or 2 above and your income is at or below 185% Federal Poverty Level, you MUST apply at nheasy.nh.gov between November 15th and December 15th, 2024 to receive your grocery money card.

Families can expect to receive \$120.00 per eligible child
