1. Housekeeping & Governance:

- a) Penny motioned, Sam seconded, and the board unanimously voted to approve the October minutes with no amendments.
- b) Ed went over the B6 Staff Treatment and Compensation. Vanessa motioned, Dani seconded, and the board unanimously voted to approve the report.
- c) Tim motioned, Sam seconded, and Jim opposed that the Co-op board will continue to be a volunteer service with the possibility of a yearly gift based on current Co-op circumstances and will be voted on each year in November. The motion passed 7-1.

2) General Manager's Report:

- a) Financial update:
 - i) We're expecting a record week for Christmas week, and we may hit \$500k in weekly sales for the first time ever.
 - ii) Weekly sales growth has been consistent lately at or above budget projections.
- b) Other Topics:
 - i) Our Food Council gathering went very well, Sam will be giving his point of view.
 - ii) Marketing for the Holiday Season has started in earnest.
 - iii) We have a Flash Discount Day Wednesday for Wine & Specialty Cheese this Wednesday, 20% off.



- iv) We'll be having a Holiday Fest tasting event on December 10th, it will be a regular
 Member Discount day as well.
- v) We have an aggressive three week BOGO marketing campaign starting 12/14.
- vi) I thought our first joint coop committee meeting went well.
- vii) I sent you all a recording of our meeting with Michelle Schrye from NCG, let me know if you had technical issues.
- viii) One topic discussed was where we should be incorporated, NH Cooperative Law has its shortcomings.
- ix) We've had comments from Members questioning why we retained 80% of our Net Income, we'll work on the wording of our Patronage letter for future rebates.
- x) We'll have a new Workers Comp insurer for 2023.
- xi) We'll be changing our Benefits Broker in 2023 but keeping our provider so there is little impact on employees.
- xii) Dawn Holtz is officially our new HR Manager.
- xiii) Marketing is working on a plan for displaying Board photos. Get those new headshots:)
- xiv) We'll be closing as usual for Thanksgiving and Christmas this year. We'll be doing a floor wax on Thanksgiving to reduce shopping impacts.
- xv) Still researching doing indigenous land acknowledgements as part of our DEI work. Waiting to hear back from the Cowasuck Band.
