The Littleton Consumer Cooperative Society will strive to:

- 1. Provide the local region with a retail source of food that is affordable, healthy, grown and/or processed locally to the fullest extent possible.
- 2. Return economic value to the community via charitable contributions, outreach projects, patronage refunds to Members, and other avenues.
- 3. Educate customers about food issues so that they are able to make healthier choices than those who shop elsewhere.
- 4. Foster and support a vibrant cooperative sector in the economy, both nationally and regionally, and a local community educated in the value of cooperative principles and enterprises.
- 5. Encourage and sustain a vibrant local agricultural community in the Co-op's bioregion by providing a reliable retail market for its products.
- 6. Be a major source of employment in the community that provides personal satisfaction to employees, livable wages, and financial security for employees and their families.
- 7. Develop and maintain a thriving business organization that protects and restores the environment.

This policy shall be monitored by reviewing the GM's annual Management report to the membership in January.
